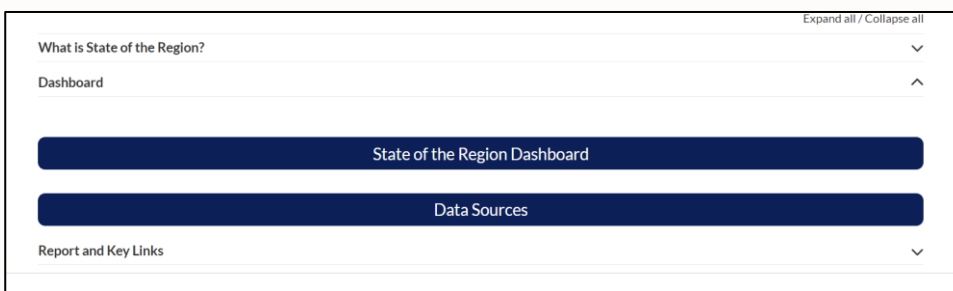
1. Access

The webpage has three sections:

Click on the **State of the Region Dashboard** button to be taken to the live dashboard.



Once loaded, use scroll down on your controls to begin navigating the dashboard narrative.

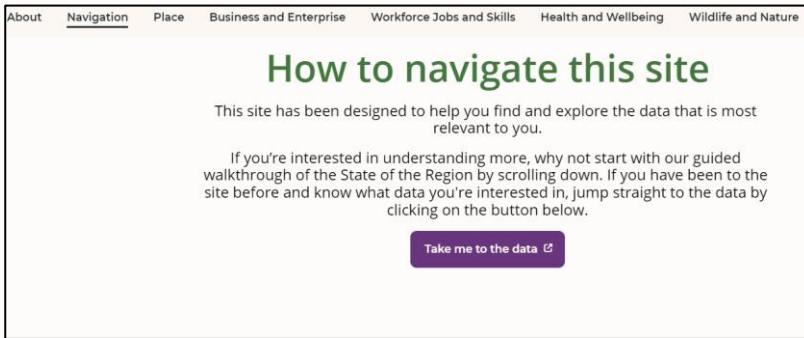


The State of the Region themes are shown across the header menu. Click on any of the themes to see the corresponding indicators and maps.

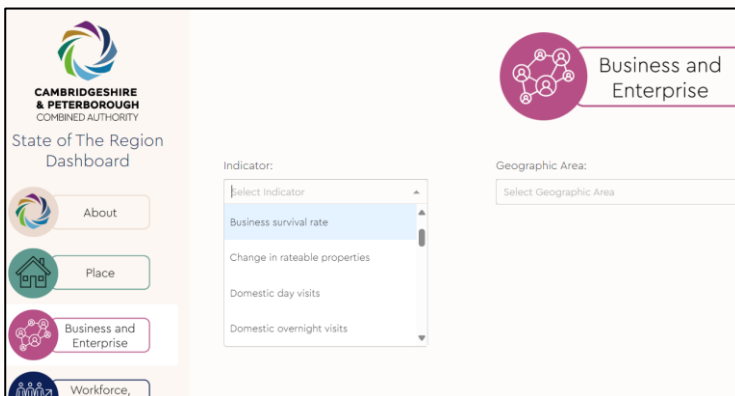


2. Navigate

To navigate to the data, select the **Navigation** menu option. Then click on the **Take me to the data** button.



Select themes from the left side panel. Once a theme is selected, use the **Indicator** field to select from the dropdown or type the name of the indicator. Use the **Geographic Area** field to select your locations.



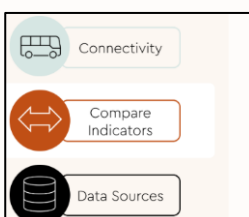
3. Interact

The corresponding chart will be automatically shown. You can select/deselect the locations to update the chart. Click on the **View data table** button to see the data in a table. Click on the **View on map** button to see the data spatially mapped.



4. Make comparisons

Select the **Compare Indicators** button, from the left side panel, to be able to compare indicators of your choosing.



Select all the indicators you wish to compare, along with all the locations. The selected indicators will automatically be shown underneath, stacked on top of each other.

5. Get the raw data

Select the **Data Sources** button, from the left side panel, to see a list of all the indicators and their respective sources, and to be able to download the raw data.

You will be taken to the list of every State of the Region indicator, along with their corresponding data source. Click on the **Download raw data** button to download a spreadsheet of all the raw data.
